ZAGREB

TRANSPORT FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE CITY

Pleso shuttle bus - https://bit.ly/3qnwJkv

One way ticket is **5 euros (you CAN pay only here in euros!)** and bought in the bus from the driver - the buses leave every half hour, timetable is on the link.

Taxi - we recommend using Bolt/Uber since the regular taxis at the airport are very expensive.

Public bus - there is a public bus line 290 but it takes some time.

TRANSPORT AROUND ZAGREB

Paper tickets may be purchased in ZET's ticket offices or at kiosks of our partners.

Each individual zone requires the appropriate paper ticket for the ride. For a ride within the first or second zone during daytime transport there are paper tickets at the price of **4 kunas**, which is valid for **30 minutes**, paper tickets at the price of **7 kunas**, which is valid for **60 minutes**, well as paper tickets which cost **10 kunas** and are valid for **90 minutes**.

In contrast to the stored-value card, a single i.e. paper ticket is valid for travel in one direction only and the ticket has to be cancelled immediately upon boarding the vehicle.

The tickets that can also be bought from the driver are tickets worth 6 kunas which are valid 30 min, then tickets at the price 10 kunas which are valid 60 min and tickets worth 15 kunas, which are valid 90 minutes in one way and in one tariff zone, and daily tickets. Tickets at the price of 6 and 10 kuna are valid only in the first tariff zone. Machines for validating paper tickets are installed near the first door of the vehicle, whereas in low-floor trams they are also installed at the rear door.

Bus lines connect the broader city centre to other parts of the town, for example, to New Zagreb. Some of the bus hubs are: main station, Mažuranić Square, Kvaternik Square, Relković Street, Črnomerec, Remiza. Daily tram and bus lines drive until 11 PM ca.

At night, we recommend using Bolt, Uber or taxi service, since trams and buses are irregular and rare. The cheapest taxi services are Uber/Bolt, Cammeo (1717) and Eco Taxi (1414 or via web: https://www.ekotaxi.hr/en). If you want to pay by card, you should announce that first. At taxi stations, you will find Radio Taxi Zagreb (so called 'Yellow Cab'), but it is mostly more expensive and only accepts cash.

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Banks, ATMS, currency and exchange offices

The most common banks in Zagreb are Zagrebačka banka (UniCredit Group), Privredna banka Zagreb (Intesa San Paolo Group), Raiffeisen Bank and Erste Bank. There are also unidentified, international ATMs near the stations. The fee is between 10 kn and 10 % of the amount.

The Croatian currency is kuna. One kuna is 0,13 EUR / 0.15 US Dollar. You can find exchange offices all around the town, but they are usually open until 8 or 9 PM — so keep that in mind!

Free WiFi

At the airport, WiFi is free of charge for 60 minutes.

In the town, WiFi is free of charge in the most of the cafes and restaurants, as well as in the Laguna Hotel, and at the Pogon/RESHAPE venues. There is also free WiFi Grad Zagreb, which should be (but not necessarily always is) available in public transport, as well as at places like squares and markets.


Hotel Laguna is located in the broader city centre, in its western part. Near the hotel, there are several popular places for night gathering or clubbing, such as <u>Medika</u>, <u>Krivi put</u> and <u>Pločnik</u>. You can also eat one of Zagreb's best pizzas in <u>Karijola</u>, literally across the street from the hotel. In the same street –

Kranjčevićeva Street – you will surely notice a stadium, which is home of FC Zagreb 041. The club is special because it is managed by its members on the principle of direct democracy.


By Uber or taxi from the airport to Laguna, it should cost you between 150 and 200 kn. Sometimes, taxi drivers will ask more – do not accept higher prices. There are cheaper ways to reach the hotel.

You can find the Croatian Airlines shuttle bus just outside the arrivals terminal, on your right. It leaves from the airport to the main bus station every 30 minutes, and it costs 30 kn or 5 euro. At the main bus station, you can take tram number 2 or 6 in the direction of Črnomerec. After three stations — at the main railway station — you have to take another tram — 9 or 4. After three more stations, you will reach either Tehnički muzej, or Studentski centar - your last stop. Now you just have to walk straight down Kranjčevićeva street.

Pogon – Jedinstvo Hall Trnjanska struga 34



POGON – Zagreb Centre for Independent Culture and Youth is a cultural institution based on the model of civil—public partnership. In 2008 it was jointly founded and managed by the Alliance Operation City and the City of Zagreb. The main function of Pogon is to provide the use of its facilities for cultural and youth programmes of Zagreb based organisations free of charge. Therefore, Pogon is – at both addresses – frequent home of NGOs and artists.

Pogon Jedinstvo is located in Staro Trnje ("Old" Trnje), a blue-collar neighbourhood with a rich history of unrealized city plans. For this reason it is often perceived as a space scarcely touched by urbanization. However, the elderly residents see it as "Zagreb as it used to be". Not waiting for the comprehensive solutions for this area, the former Jedinstvo factory imposed itself as the essential place for the creation and presentation of independent culture and youth, in which Močvara, Pogon and DB Indoš have worked for years. With its cultural activity, Pogon contributes to the development of the neighbourhood, at the same time trying to be a good neighbour and host to the residents of Staro Trnje.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Walk for 3 minutes to Badalićeva tram station toward the city center. Hop on tram number 3 "SAVIŠĆE". Ride for 7 stops and hop off at Lisinski tram station. Walk for about 5 min to the bus station Lisinski and take bus 219, 220, 221, 234 or 268 for one station then walk to Pogon Jedinstvo for 5 minutes.

The artistic organization Ateliers Žitnjak was founded in 2004 by its artists- in the complex of the old school Žitnjak, Žitnjak 53, a venue that the City of Zagreb transformed into ateliers. The organization was established on the model of various international art centres: in the industrial zone, with the intention of creating an art center that would contribute to the cultural and social revitalization of the peripheral, culturally neglected industrial area of Žitnjak. As part of the Atelier, the AŽ Gallery was founded in 2005 as a multi-purpose exhibition space, with about 150 exhibitions and other cultural events held so far. Members of the Atelier Žitnjak Arts Organization are prominent Croatian artists, and its manager, Bojan Krištofić, one of the Reshapers!

Transportation is organized from hotel Laguna to the venue on the first day. The departure from hotel Laguna by bus is at 18:00h. You can return to hotel Laguna by the same bus at 22:00 or 00:00. The bus will be in front of Ateliers Žitnjak venue. If you wish to stay later than 00:00, you can return by Uber/Bolt at your own cost.

Important! On September 22nd, a bus will pick you up at hotel Laguna at 10 am for our departure to Ljubljana.




The Old Power Station well be the central venue of the RESHAPE conference. The conference registration, the lunches and dinners will be served here, it will also be the meeting point before the City walks.


