








N° OF FOREIGN (CO-)PRODUCERS IN FLEMISH PERFORMING ARTS



January 2016 - Research showing the exponential growth of transnational partnerships in 'Flemish' performances







"Right now both Maria Hassabi and Trajal Harrell are essentially art nomads, calling Belgium, France, Greece and US their temporary bases."
